Many polytechnic students look forward to their 3rd year of school as they will complete their studies soon and many opportunities await them. However, this was not the case for Nurhidayah who found a lump on her neck in 2016 and was subsequently diagnosed with stage 2 Hodgkin's Lymphoma. It came without a warning to her as there was no history of cancer in her family.

Shocked and lost, she turned to Singapore Cancer Society (SCS) for help. She was worried about the treatment cost and other out-of-pocket expenses which would drain her family's limited resources. Fortunately, she received various financial aids such as SCS Cancer Care Fund, Cancer Treatment Fund and Welfare Assistance. These fundings lifted the heavy burden off her family and kept them focused to support her in her journey.

Nurhidayah had to undergo 48 hours of chemotherapy over 12 sessions in just 6 months. It was emotionally and physically demanding for a young girl like her. However, she is a determined fighter who will not give up on her studies. Her hard work finally paid off as she successfully graduated and went on to secure a job as a coordinator in a production company.
