临床评估和治疗

在家访的时候,我们会评估病患、看护者以及家人的需求。 护理团队会协助病患如何缓解疼痛和气喘等症状,并教导 看护者如何照料病患。

■心理社会服务



■家中复建

我们的治疗师会评估并培训病患及看护者,以通过适合病患的运动来维持并加强其身体功能。家中复建服务也包括家居改造以及看护者的培训。

设备租借

我们为病患提供设备租借服务,包括制氧机和注射泵以及 康复设备,如轮椅、便桶和助行器。

SCS Hospice Care

Singapore Cancer Society (SCS) provides holistic hospice care for patients with advanced cancer in the comfort of their own homes.

The patients we serve wish to receive home palliative care and are suitable to receive it. We accept patients through doctors' referrals.

Our SCS Hospice Care team comprises of Medical and Allied health professionals who make regular visits to our patients and their families to provide:

Clinical Assessment and Treatment

During home visits, we assess the needs of patients, their caregivers, and their families. We also provide help in managing symptoms like pain and breathlessness as well as teach caregivers how to care for their loved ones.



Psychosocial Services

We support patients and their caregivers by means of financial assistance, psychosocial, emotional, and spiritual support. We seek to accompany all our patients and their families on the cancer journey by listening to and understanding their needs as well as offering assistance and support where necessary. We also offer bereavement support to family members and caregivers in the months following the death of a patient.

Home Rehabilitation

Our therapists assess and train our patients and their caregivers on exercises aimed at maintaining their function in day to day activities. Home rehabilitation also includes home modification and caregiver training.

Loan of Equipment

We loan equipment such as oxygen concentrators and syringe drivers as well as rehabilitative equipment such as wheelchairs, commodes, and walking aids to our patients.

Welfare & Cancer Support Services

Cancer Care Fund

This one-time financial assistance scheme aims to alleuviate the financial burden of newly-diagnosed cancer patients who come from low or middle income families within the first 6 months of their diagnosis of cancer.

Cancer Treatment Fund

For eligible patients,* we provide subsidies on costs incurred for investigative procedures and cancer treatments - including but not limited to chemotherapy, surgery, Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy (IMRT) - which are not covered under the National Healthcare Financing Schemes such as Medisave/ Medishield, Medication Assistance Fund, and Medical Endownment Fund (Medifund).

Welfare Aid

We provide monthly cash aid to eligible patients for daily needs,* and medical supplies as recommended by the medical team. These supplies include but are not limited to ostomy bags, milk supplements, dressing items, breast prosthesis, and speech aid prosthesis.



Living-Well Programme

We enhance dignity of care and quality living for financially needy patients by enabling them to reside in their homes until their last days, by fulfilling last wishes, and enabling legacy building. This includes but is not limited to services such as ambulance, transport, certificate of cause of death arrangements, last rites arrangements, nursing aide, purchase or rental of medical equipment, outings, and legal expenses.

Free Transport to/from Hospital

We provide free hospital-to-home transport for eligible patients receiving treatment in restructured hospitals.2



SCS Help the Children and Youth Programme

This joint programme, co-funded by the SingTel Touching Lives Fund, provides Education Financial Assistance Schemes (EFAS) like school allowance and bursaries, book prizes and achievement awards, tuition services, family engagement programmes, and camps for children and youths impacted by cancer.

我们为经济欠佳的病患者提升护理和生活素质,让他们能 在家里居住直到他们人生最后的日子、助他们达成临终的 愿望以及财富承传案。这些项目也包于救护车、接送、死 亡因素证书的安排、丧礼安排、末期私人看护、医疗设备 的采购或租赁、外出以及法律费用等的援助。

来往医院的免费接送服务

我们提供接送符合条件的患者来往医院的服务。2
